

RESOLUTION NO. BHO 16-04

A RESOLUTION OF THE THURSTON MASON BEHAVIORAL HEALTH ORGANIZATION GOVERNING BOARD ESTABLISHING A "NON-COUNTY" FUND ACCOUNT WITH THE THURSTON COUNTY TREASURER

WHEREAS, chapter 39.34 RCW permits local governmental entities to make the most efficient use of their powers by enabling them to cooperate with other localities on the basis of mutual advantage; and

WHEREAS, RCW 71.24.015 encourages county authorities (as defined in RCW 71.24.025 (3) effective April 1, 2016) to enter into joint operating agreements with other county authorities to form Behavioral Health Organizations; and

WHEREAS, chapters 71.05 and 71.24 RCW allow counties and other entities to establish Behavioral Health Organizations to integrate planning, administration, and service delivery duties assigned to the Counties; and

WHEREAS, on September 15, 2015, the Thurston County and Mason County Board of County Commissioners adopted Resolution No. 15183 establishing the Thurston Mason Behavioral Health Organization pursuant to chapter 71.24 RCW, in which it is stated in 3g. TMBHO funds shall be deposited with the Thurston County Treasurer who shall be the custodian of such funds. The Thurston County Treasurer may make payments from such funds upon audit by the Thurston County Auditor as provided for in RCW 71.24.100. The Thurston County Treasurer shall establish a special fund to be designated "Operating Fund of Thurston Mason BHO". Interest on investment of TMBHO funds shall accrue for the benefit of said operating fund.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that Thurston Mason BHO shall deposit funds with the Thurston County Treasurer as a "Non-County" fund to be labeled – "Operating Fund of Thurston Mason BHO".


