

RESOLUTION NO. BHO 17-06

A RESOLUTION CREATING 25 POSITIONS, CREATING A PAY AND CLASSIFICATION SYSTEM, AND ACCEPTING THE ONE-TIME TRANSFER OF ACCRUED LEAVE FROM THURSTON COUNTY EMPLOYEES WHO WILL BEGIN EMPLOYMENT WITH THE THURSTON-MASON BEHAVIORAL HEALTH ORGANIZATION ON OR BEFORE AUGUST 16, 2017

WHEREAS, on September 15, 2015, Thurston County and Mason County entered into an interlocal agreement to form the Thurston-Mason Behavioral Health Organization (TMBHO) under chapter 71.24 RCW; and

WHEREAS, the First Amendment of the Interlocal Agreement between Thurston and Mason County established the intent for Thurston-Mason Behavioral Health Organization to organize as a separate and legal entity with its own employees.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Governing Board of the Thurston-Mason Behavioral Health Organization resolves as follows:

- Section 1. The positions listed in Attachment A are created effective August 1, 2017.
- Section 2. Establish Pay and Classification System as listed in Attachment B, effective August 1, 2017.
- Section 3. The TMBHO approves the cash out and transfer of accrued leave from employees who were employed with Thurston County on or before August 16, 2017. Thurston-Mason Behavioral Health Organization Employee Handbook, Paid Time Off rules shall not apply.
