

Resolution No. 18-10

A RESOLUTION of the Thurston-Mason Behavioral Health Organization (TMBHO) governing board requesting review by the Health Care Authority (HCA) to participate in the Washington State Insurance Plans.

WHEREAS, the Health Care Authority administers the medical, dental, life, and long term disability insurance coverage for the employees of the state of Washington, as set forth in chapter 41.05 RCW;

WHEREAS, the TMBHO governing board representing the Thurston-Mason Behavioral Health Organization has reviewed the state insurance plans, chapter 41.05 RCW, RCW 41.04.205, chapter 182-08 WAC, and chapter 182-12 WAC; and,

WHEREAS, we deem the state insurance plans as providing desirable insurance coverage for employees; and,

WHEREAS, we certify that all employees (and members of the Governing Body) enrolled are eligible to participate in the state insurance plans;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that Thurston-Mason Behavioral Health Organization requests approval by the Health Care Authority to participate in the state insurance plans for the employees of the TMBHO, subject to the requirement of RCW 41.04.205 and the rules adopted thereunder.
